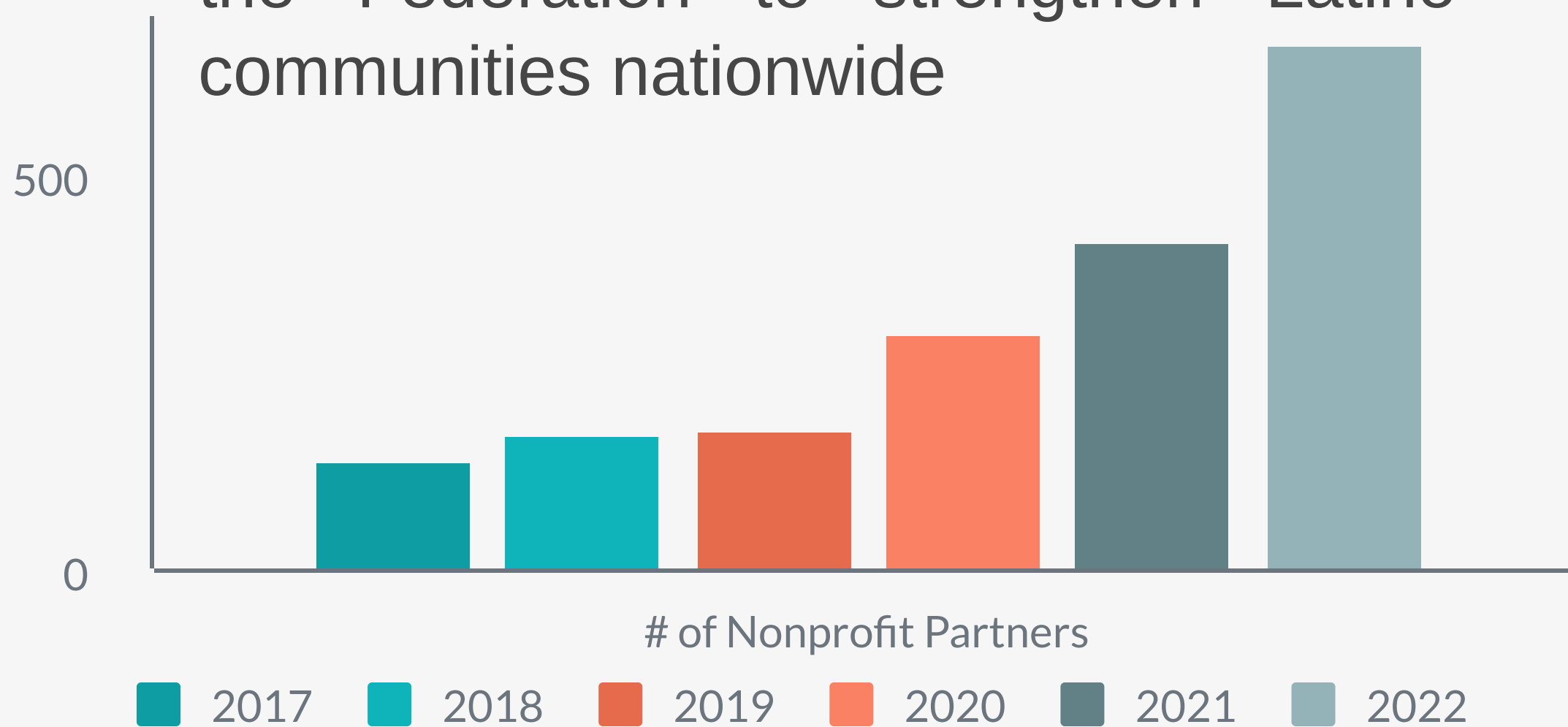

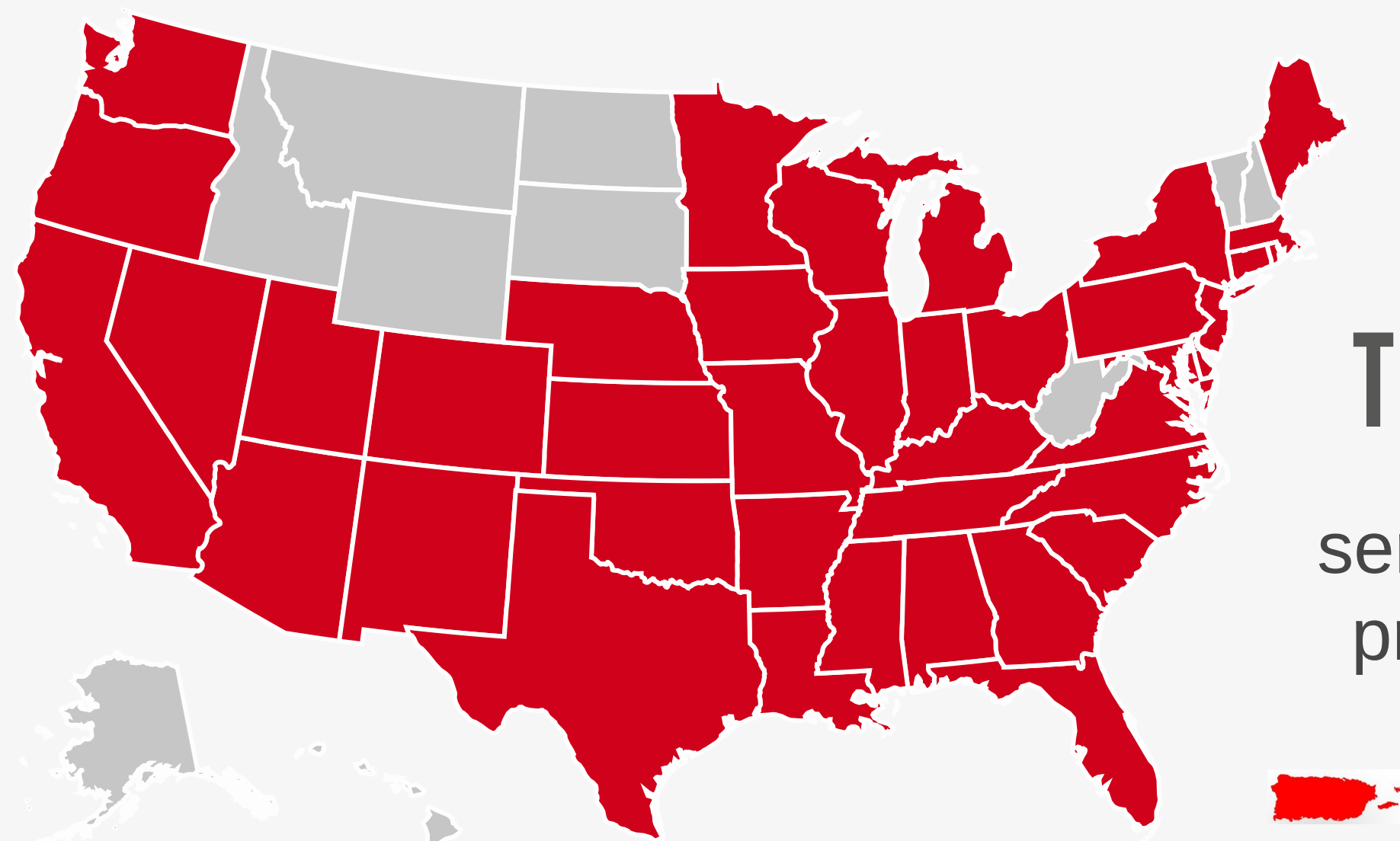

379,000

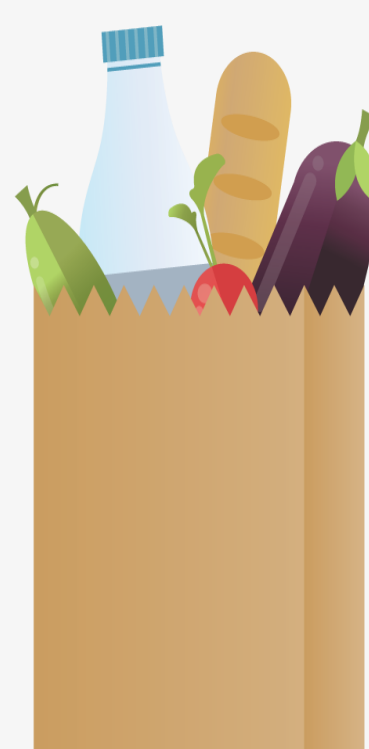

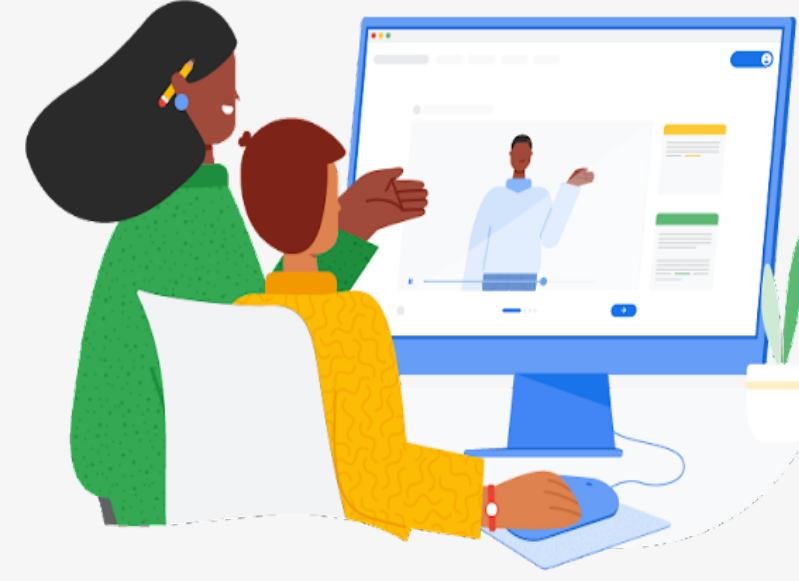
Latino nonprofit leaders were provided professional development trainings through 26 online webinars and 12 in person sessions

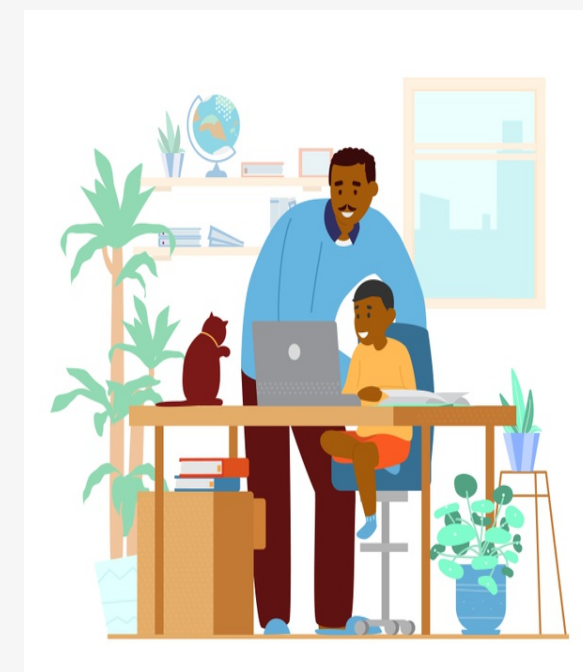
Latinos were vaccinated through our COVID-19 assistance efforts
