RE: Withdrawal of Emergency Rule: 65CER21-3-Standards for Unaccompanied Alien Children (UAC) Homes and Unaccompanied Refugee Minor Programs under the Florida State Department of Children and Families Division of Family Safety and Preservation Program

Dear Governor DeSantis,

On behalf of the Hispanic Federation and its network of Latino community-based member organizations and partners across the state, we write to strongly urge you to withdraw Emergency Rule 65CER21-3 presented in the Florida Administrative Code (FAC) on December 10, 2021. Executive Rule 65CER21-3 establishes enormous burdens on state federally contracted nonprofit caregivers and businesses - such as child-placing agencies and residential child-caring agencies - to apply for, renew, and maintain their state licenses and inflicts extreme and adverse deprivations to the most vulnerable minor children in need of care in our state.

We are asking for your swift action in withdrawing the Standards for Unaccompanied Alien Children (UAC) Homes and Unaccompanied Refugee Minor Programs. The issuance and renewal of state licenses via the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) is a critical component in ensuring the wellbeing and safety of all children in licensed care facilities and homes. The proposed executive rule poses the following undue burden(s):

- Restricting the ability of foster families, shelters, and faith-based organizations to serve vulnerable children and families by requiring them to choose only one group of vulnerable children to serve.
- Eliminating access of qualified federally contracted child-caring and serving organizations to necessary licensing applications and approval.
- Forcible removal of minor children from stable and supportive care facilities and homes due to loss of licensure under the new rule.

These committed organizations, in partnership with the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF), assist the most vulnerable individuals in our communities, and in this case, susceptible minor children seeking asylum under the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Refugee Settlement (ORR). Foster care and shelter facilities are critical components in the family reunification and sponsoring process.

We note that unaccompanied children who arrive in the United States without legal guardians are granted special protection under the William Wilberforce Trafficking Victims Protection Reauthorization Act (TVPRA). This law requires unaccompanied minors from non-contiguous countries who are received by



the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to be transferred into the custody of the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). To keep these children safe, ORR relies on a network of childcare providers, including faith-based organizations, to provide temporary care in shelters or foster families until the child reunites with their vetted and approved family member or sponsor. These childcare providers are legally required to be licensed by stateofficials to ensure proper state oversight and the wellbeing of children. Blocking access to issuance and renewal of these state licenses prevents families from serving as foster parents for migrant children and prevents agencies from coordinating care for children in need of foster care families – including those that are Florida-born.

We look to you to ensure that all of Florida's children, regardless of where they were born, have the right and inherent dignity to grow healthy and thrive in safe, stable caring environments. We look forward to your response and to working together to serve in the best interests of all of Florida's children.
